Gas and Electric Bill Assistance - LIHEAP

What is it?

 A program to relieve stress on your household's budget and keep the utilities running.

How does it help?

 Provides a one-time benefit toward gas and electric bills.

Additional Gas and Electric Bill Assistance

Peoples Gas Share the Warmth

One-time grant of up to \$200 for Peoples Gas home-heating bills.

ComEd Residential Hardship

Grant of up to \$500 once every two years for ComEd electric bills.



Furnace Repair and Replacement

What is it?

 A program that repairs or replaces broken or unsafe home heating systems.

How does it help?

Repairs or replaces home furnaces and boilers.

Homeowners who meet the new and expanded income guidelines

Home Weatherization

What is it?

 Home improvements that keep houses warmer in the winter and cooler in the summer.

How does it help?

- Attic and wall installation
- Draft sealing
- Indoor air quality improvement
- Furnace/boiler and water heater replacement





Home Weatherization

Do members of my community qualify?

- New and expanded income guidelines
 - If <u>a home</u> was weatherized on or after 9/30/1994, follow the 150% guidelines. Otherwise, follow the 200% guidelines.
