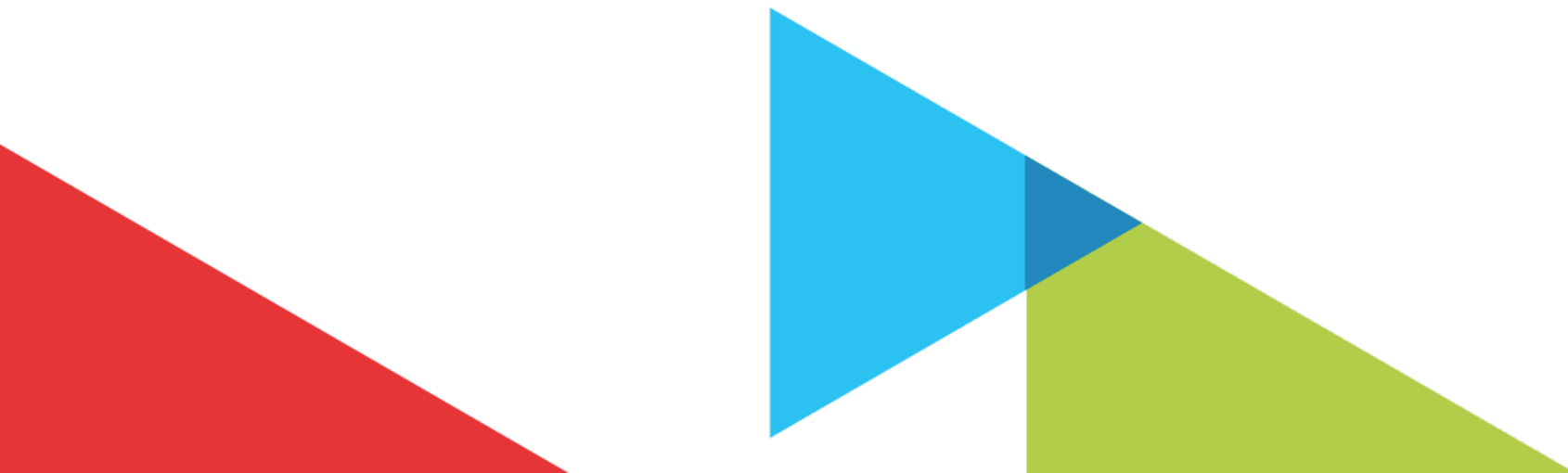

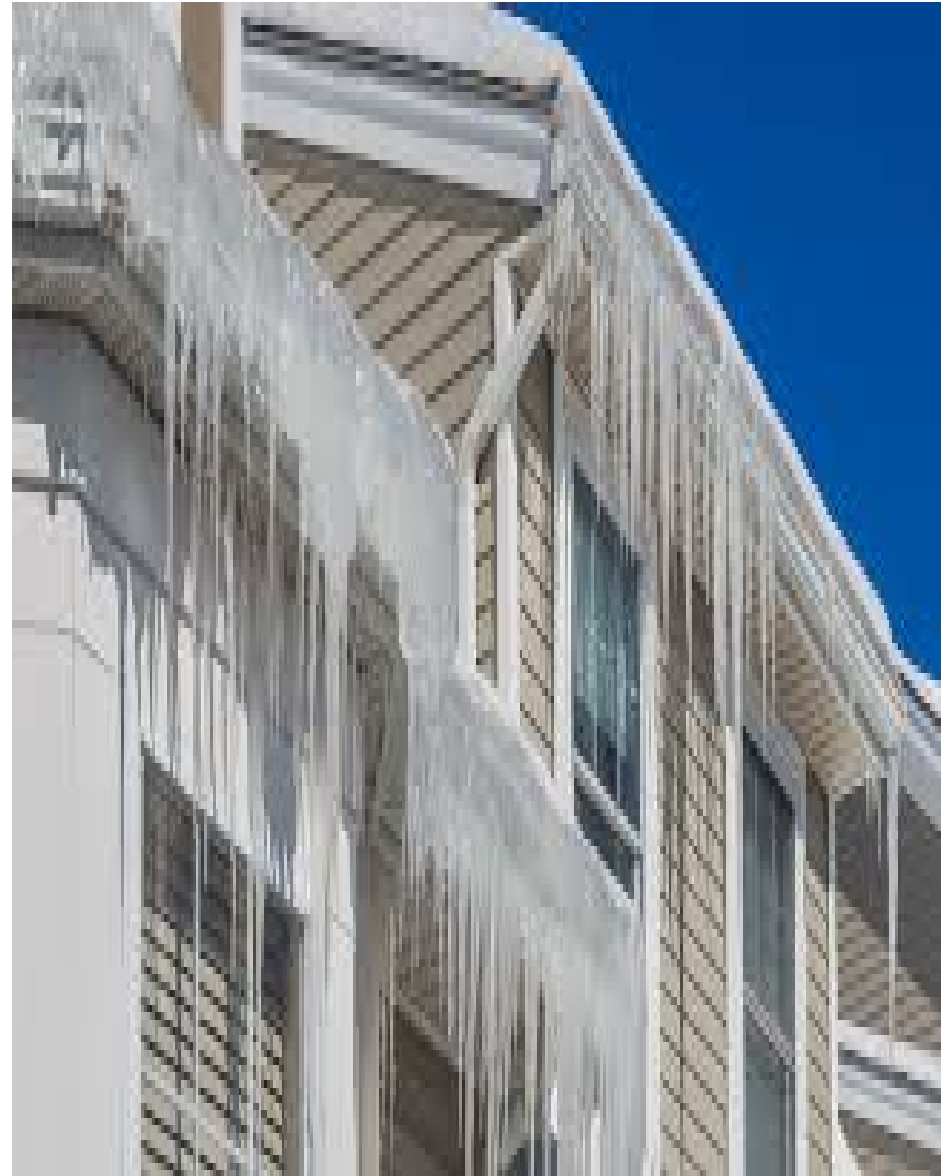

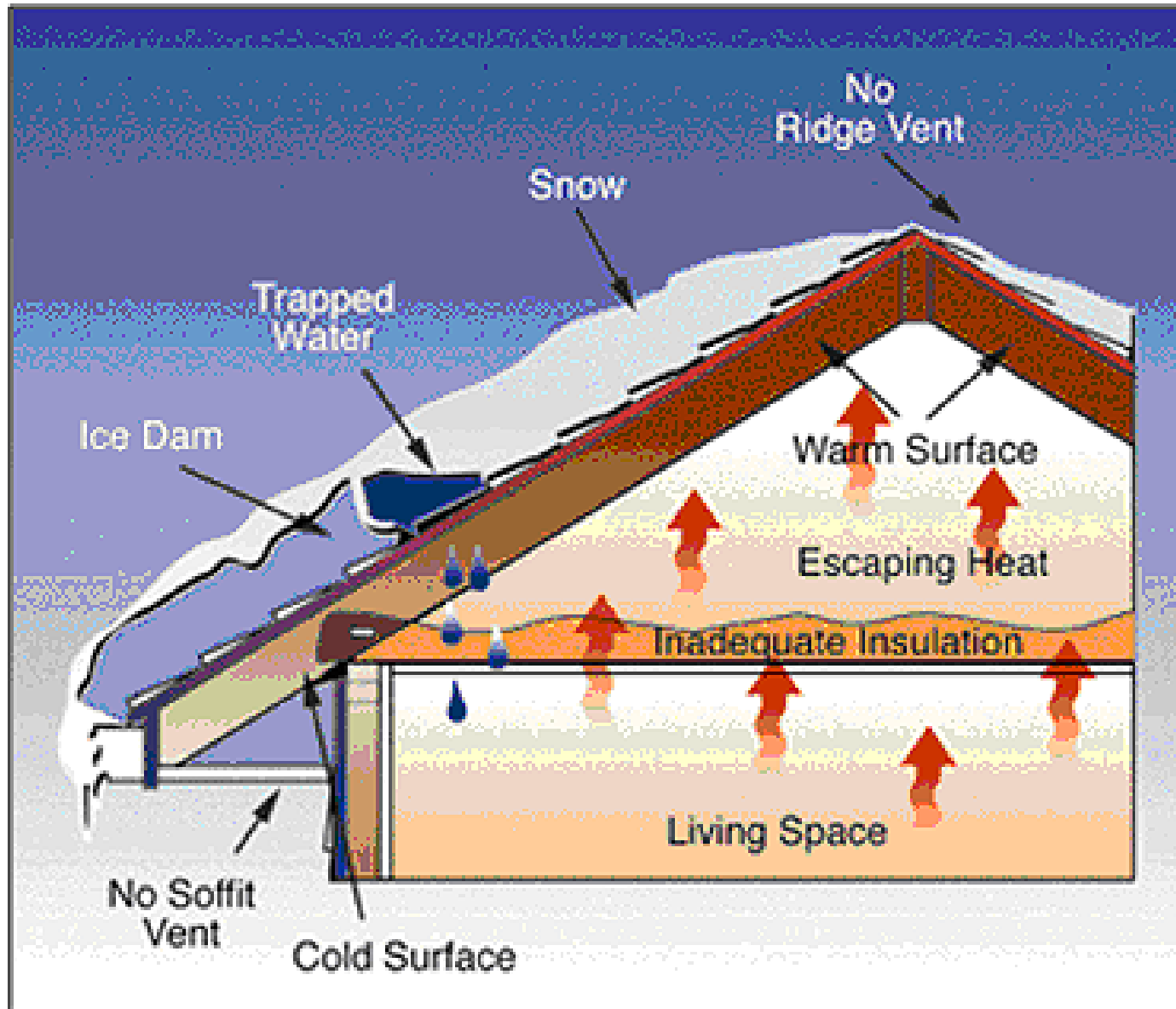

CAA Channel Weatherization



- What is the CAA Channel?
 - Increase energy efficiency as well as health and safety upgrades
 - Local agencies identify customers, perform energy audits, and then complete retrofits
 - Offers both electric and gas savings
- Gas measures include:
 - Air sealing & Insulation
 - HVAC
 - Direct install measures (e.g., aerators, showerheads)
 - Health and safety

CAA Channel Weatherization



- Eligibility:
 - Households under 80% AMI are eligible
 - Single family, multi-family and manufactured homes
 - Homeowners and renters are eligible
- How to apply:
 - Local community action agencies determine eligibility

CAA Channel Water-Saving and Weatherization Kits



Both kits are easy to install, delivered right to your door, and designed to help you **start saving money and energy right away.**



Your FREE water-saving kit includes:

- ▶ High-efficiency showerhead
- ▶ Shower timer
- ▶ Dual-spray faucet aerator
- ▶ Bathroom faucet aerator
- ▶ Plumber's tape



Your FREE weatherization kit includes:

- ▶ Door sweep
- ▶ Foam weatherstrip
- ▶ Rope caulk
- ▶ Switch and outlet wall gaskets
- ▶ V-seal weatherstrip

Contractor Channel



- What is the Contractor Channel?
 - Increase energy efficiency as well as health and safety upgrades
 - Installation subcontractors conduct outreach with city officials, community groups, and property managers to connect with customers
- Measures include:
 - Air sealing & Insulation
 - HVAC
 - Health and safety services

Contractor Channel



- Eligibility:
 - Households under 80% AMI are eligible
 - Single family, multi-family and manufactured homes
 - Homeowners and renters with landlord approval are eligible
- How to apply:
 - Directly with installation subcontractors
 - Single-family customers can call Urban Efficiency, LLC at 1-844-857-0267
 - Multi-family customers can visit Anura Energy at anuraenergy.org/contact

Public Housing Authority Program (PHA)



- What is PHA?
 - Incentives for upgrades of building systems generally found in PHA buildings that will result in overall reduction in natural gas consumption of the buildings
- Measures include:
 - Direct installation of electric and gas measures.
 - Air sealing & insulation
 - HVAC (including boilers, central plants, hot water circulation controls, and tune ups)

Public Housing Authority Program (PHA)



- Eligibility:
 - Residents of Public Housing Authorities in Nicor Gas territory
 - Income eligibility varies based on requirements of Public Housing Authority
 - Predominantly multifamily
- How to apply:
